## March - Maryland, My Maryland

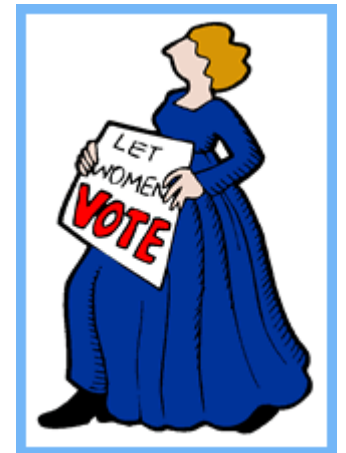
How did Maryland become a state? We'll explore our history and the origins of our state symbols.
