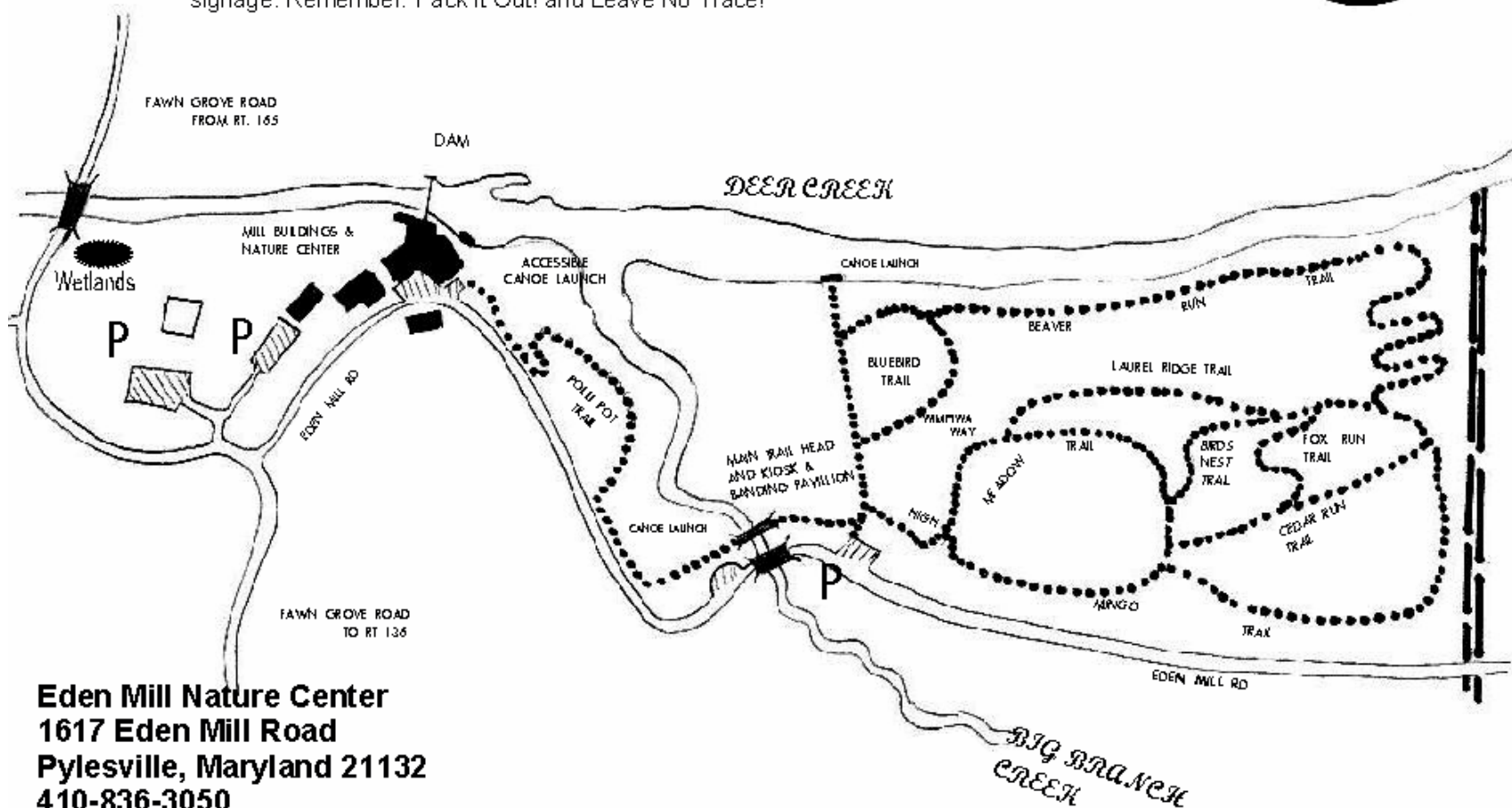


EDEN MILL NATURE CENTER HIKING TRAILS

TRAIL INFORMATION

TRAIL RATINGS: ● EASY

MODERATE

- **POLLIPOT TRAIL:** Starts at Mill and follows wetlands along Big Branch Creek to main trailhead. Parts are elevated on a boardwalk. .3 miles (.48 km)
- **BEAVER RUN TRAIL:** Follows Deer Creek great bottomlands habitat for beaver. .29 miles (.47 km)
- **BLUEBIRD TRAIL:** Succession area, foxes, rabbits, deer, blue birds. Easy hiking. .17 miles (.27 km)
- **MINGO TRAIL:** Follows the upper meadow, great birding. .19 miles (.3 km)
- # **WIMPIWA WAY:** Connector trail from Bluebird Trail to High Meadow Trail. .05 mi. (.14km)
- # **CEDAR RUN TRAIL:** Follows the edge of the forest on one side and the meadow on the other. Joins up with Laurel Ridge Trail at switchbacks. .19 miles (.31km)
- & **HIGH MEADOW TRAIL:** Starts at main trailhead. Follows the edge of the high meadow and forest. Steep climb at beginning of trail. .3 miles (.48 km)
- & **LAUREL RIDGE TRAIL:** A forest trail overlooking Deer Creek, steep switchbacks.

To experience the greatest variety of flora and fauna in the Park, take a loop hike. Be creative! Start at the Mill and link together many trails that will lead you through different terrain and ecosystems. Try a new route each time you visit!

- PARK RULES -

For your safety and to preserve the features of the area, **PLEASE** observe the following regulations. Thank You.

NO BIKES, CYCLES, MOTOR VEHICLES, OR HORSES ALLOWED

WILDLIFE:

- [A] Do not pursue, catch, molest, or kill any wildlife or disturb the nest, den, or burrow thereof.
- [B] Do not permit any other domesticated animal to run at large or create a nuisance- keep pets on leash
- [C] Do not pick flowers or disturb other plants.

DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY:

Do not deface, alter, injure or disturb any monument, boundary line, physical structure, land, installation, notice, sign, historical or prehistoric ruins.

FIRES:

Do not build or cause to be built any fire except within designated areas. Do not leave any fire unless attended by a responsible person.

SWIMMING:

Swimming is not permitted within the Park.

CAMPING:

Camping is not permitted.
